



## **Madison to host Electronics Recycling day May 7th**

Madison Communications will host an "Ecycling Day" on Saturday, May 7th at their Staunton office located at 21668 Double Arch Road. Appliances and electronic devices may be recycled between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and noon. Anything metal with a cord will be accepted. TV sets will be accepted for a cash fee of \$5 to \$30 per TV, depending on size. The cost will be determined by the recycling vendor at the event. Only 1 CRT computer monitor will be accepted and must accompany a computer tower.

Area residents are encouraged to join Madison in their "go green" efforts to reduce waste and recycle. Some of Madison's other "go green" projects include the SmartHub Online Bill Pay system where customers can sign up at Madison's website for paperless billing. E-payment options include credit and debit card, as well as ACH (automatic withdrawal). Madison also participates in paper recycling by shredding discarded paper and donating it to Adopt-A-Pet in Benld for their animal shelter.
