



## **Madison Hosts Flu Vaccination Clinic October 7<sup>th</sup> in Staunton**

Madison Communications Company will be hosting a Vaccination Clinic at their main office at 21668 Double Arch Road in Staunton on Friday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, from 10:00 a.m. to noon. VNA-Tip will be providing flu and pneumonia vaccines. This vaccination program is aimed at reducing the occurrence of flu and interruption of life activities.

This clinic is opened to the public. A Vaccination Consent Form must be completed by all who wish to have a vaccine. VNA-Tip HealthCare will bill Medicare Part B, Advantra (Medicare HMO)/GHP, Mercy Premier (Medicare HMO), Essence (Medicare HMO), Health Alliance, and all others must have cash or a check.

Restrictions require that all participants 13 to 18 years of age and anyone who is or might be pregnant have a doctor's order. You will not be eligible for a flu shot if you are sick, have a fever or are taking antibiotics, have an allergic reaction to eggs or have had a previous allergic reaction to a flu shot. The flu shot is recommended for all people 6 months of age and older, and is especially suggested for those at higher risk of severe influenza.

All adults 65 years of age and older are advised to receive the pneumonia vaccine. Those younger in age who have long-term health problems or certain diseases that lower the body's resistance to infection are also advised to have this vaccine.
