



Madison Offers Internet Workshops in Staunton

On April 14th and 15th, Madison will be hosting Internet workshops free to the public. Reservations are required and seating will be limited, so it is recommended that you call early to reserve a seat.

Two sessions will be offered on Thursday, April 14th for beginning Internet users. The Internet Basics class will be offered in the morning from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. and again in the afternoon from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. Then, on April 15th, morning and afternoon sessions will be offered on "File Sharing and Photo Management."

To register for one of these classes, residents should contact Madison's business office by dialing 1-800-422-4848 between the hours of 8:00 and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. When calling to register, please indicate the course you wish to attend and whether you prefer the morning or afternoon session. A valid contact phone number and email address will also be required at the time of the reservation.

The Internet Basics workshop is recommended for people new to the Internet who want to become familiar with how to use browsers, how to save favorite sites, and how to conduct web searches. This course also touches on social networking and other basic Internet features.

The Files and Photo Management course is recommended for anyone who has used email and is interested in learning how to effectively download and store photos and files.
